## MRS. BURT LUM

was born in Iowa. Graduate in design and life classes at Chicago Art Institute. Studied at the Holmes School of Illustration, under Leyendecker, and color under Annie Weston. Went to Japan nine years ago, learning the process of woodblock cutting. Returned to Japan four years later, working several months under a native block cutter, and six weeks under a printer. Again went to Japan a year ago, when she had printers working under her personal supervision. Exhibited at the National Exhibition at Tokio in 1912.
